AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE PURCHASE OF SIXTY-EIGHT (68) SETS OF FIREFIGHTER TURNOUT GEAR FOR USE BY THE FIRE DEPARTMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, by and through Resolution No. 2024-066, Council authorized the Mayor to advertise for bids for the purchase of sixty-eight (68) sets of Firefighter Turnout Gear for use by the Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, such bids were received and Council is desirous of proceeding to award and enter into a contract for such gear.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STRONGSVILLE, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO:

- Section 1. That this Council hereby finds and determines that the bid submitted by PHOENIX SAFETY OUTFITTERS, LLC for the purchase of sixty-eight (68) sets of Firefighter Turnout Gear meets the specifications on file in the office of the Fire Chief; is in compliance with the applicable requirements for bidding and contracts established by the laws of the City and the State; and is the lowest and best bid for the proposed contract. All other bids for this contract are hereby rejected.
- Section 2. That the Mayor be and is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with the aforesaid lowest and best bidder in an amount not to exceed \$244,732.00 for the purchase of sixty-eight (68) sets of Firefighter Turnout Gear, in accordance with the specifications on file in the office of the Fire Chief.
- **Section 3.** That the funds for the purposes of said contract have been appropriated and shall be paid from the Fire Levy Fund.
- **Section 4.** That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council; and that all deliberations of this Council, and any of its committees, that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.
- Section 5. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety and welfare of the City; and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to enter into said contract in order to protect the safety of members of the Fire Department, to aid in protecting the lives and property of individuals residing in the City, to provide for the continuity of services and operation of the Fire Department, and conserve public funds. Therefore, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

Section 1. AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO ISSUE AND APPROVE CHANGE ORDER NOS. 8 THROUGH 11 FOR AN INCREASE IN THE CONTRACT PRICE CONSISTENT WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THE CONTRACT BETWEEN THE CITY OF STRONGSVILLE AND DIGIOIA-SUBURBAN EXCAVATING, LLC, IN CONNECTION WITH THE PROSPECT ROAD STORM SEWER IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance No. 2023-130, Council authorized the Mayor to enter into a contract with Digioia-Suburban Excavating, LLC in connection with the Prospect Road Storm Sewer Improvements Project from Albion Road to Fair Road, in the City of Strongsville, (the "Project"), in an amount not to exceed \$3,607,488.50; and

WHEREAS, by and though Ordinance No. 2024-044, Council authorized the Mayor to approve Change Order Nos. 1 through 7, as recommended by the City Engineer, and that it would be in the City's best interest to include as part of the Project additional work required by the Cleveland Water Department and further work required due to unforeseen conditions encountered in connection with a watermain break, in the amount of \$150,883.95 for an increase in the total Project cost to \$3,758,372.45; and

WHEREAS, the City's Engineer has now recommended that it would be in the best interests of the City to include changes in the work performed or to be performed on the Project by Digioia-Suburban Excavating, LLC, generally being additional work required to open cut Prospect Road for the sanitary sewer lateral connections in lieu of the planned sanitary boring items due to waterline conflicts and unforeseen field conditions encountered, all as more fully set forth collectively on Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated herein as if fully rewritten, and to provide additional payment for such changes in the work in the amount of \$228,643.91, for a new total Project cost of \$3,987,016.36.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STRONGSVILLE, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor be and is hereby authorized and directed to issue and approve Change Order Nos. 8 through 11 to the contract in the amount of \$228,643.91, as recommended by the City Engineer and reflected collectively on Exhibit A; and after the issuance and approval of said Change Order Nos. 8 through 11 and completion of such work, to direct the Director of Finance to make payment to **DIGIOIA-SUBURBAN EXCAVATING, LLC** in the additional amount of \$228,643.91, thereby increasing the total Project cost to \$3,987,016.36.

Section 2. That the funds necessary for this Ordinance have been appropriated and shall be paid from the General Capital Improvement Fund, and that the Director of Finance be and is hereby authorized and directed to issue the City's warrants for payment accordingly, and in accordance with the terms and conditions of the contract and change orders.
