**NEW WALKWAYS, TRAILS & SIDEWALKS** that will better connect area amenities and promote walkability with the Town Center

**NEW WAYFINDING SIGNAGE** that will better identify area amenities/trails while creating a consistent Town Center brand

**IMPROVEMENTS TO THE EXISTING FREEDOM TRAIL** as well as walkways to the Strongsville Commons

**INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS** featuring a new roundabout as well as safe walkways to/from Pearl Road

## NEW COMMUNITY AMENITIES

**INTERACTIVE FOUNTAIN** New interactive water feature for use by children of all ages with ADA features & seasonal flexibility

**COMMUNITY PAVILION** Centrally located community gathering place featuring an enclosed event space, an outdoor fireplace and seating

**SPORT COURTS** New tennis, pickleball, sand volleyball, and half-court basketball courts

**COMMUNITY PLAYGROUND** New community playground that is fully ADA compliant to accommodate children with disabilities

**FOOD TRUCK COURT WITH PAVILION** Designed with necessary utilities and pathways to support community events

**COMMUNITY GREENSPACE** Large, open green space for community events and nature play
