





## **SAFETY TOWN INFORMATION & REGISTRATION FORM – 2020**

Safety Town is a Strongsville Police Program. The Strongsville Rotary and other civic groups sponsor this program. Safety Town is <u>not</u> mandatory prior to entering kindergarten but is an excellent opportunity for the children to explore their community through class activities and field trips while learning important safety precautions.

<u>Registration (in person only) is at the WALTER F. EHRNFELT REC AND SENIOR CENTER</u> 18100 Royalton Rd. All Safety Town classes will be held at the <u>Safety Town village</u>, next to the Strongsville Rec Center behind the Senior Center. A <u>non-refundable</u> fee of **\$50.00 (check or cash payable to The City of Strongsville)** per child must be paid at time of registration. Only children who are <u>Strongsville residents</u> and/or attend a Strongsville school and will be starting kindergarten this year, may register for Safety Town on one of the below dates & times (non-residents may apply after these dates, by calling Marie at Strongsville Police Dept.
