**A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE ADOPTION OF THE
CUYAHOGA COUNTY 2017 THROUGH 2022 ALL-
HAZARDS MITIGATION PLAN.**

WHEREAS, hazard mitigation is defined as any sustainable action taken to reduce or eliminate damage from future disaster; and

WHEREAS, the City of Strongsville is vulnerable to natural and human-made hazards which may result in loss of life and property, economic hardship and threats to public health and safety; and

WHEREAS, Section 322 of the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 (DMA 2000) requires state and local governments to develop and submit for approval to the President a mitigation plan that outlines processes for identifying their respective natural hazards, risks and vulnerabilities; and

WHEREAS, the City of Strongsville acknowledges the requirements of Section 322 of DMA 2000 to have an approved Hazard Mitigation Plan as a prerequisite to receiving post-disaster Hazard Mitigation Grant Program funds; and

WHEREAS, the Cuyahoga County 2017-2022 All-Hazards Mitigation Plan has been developed by the Cuyahoga County Office of Emergency Management in cooperation with other county departments, and officials and citizens of the City of Strongsville; and

WHEREAS, a public involvement process consistent with the requirements of DMA 2000 was conducted to develop the Cuyahoga County 2017-2022 All-Hazards Mitigation Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Cuyahoga County 2017-2022 All-Hazards Mitigation Plan recommends mitigation activities that will reduce losses to life and property affected by both natural and human-made hazards that face the County and its municipal governments; and

WHEREAS, the City's Fire Chief, having reviewed and recommended adoption of the "Cuyahoga County 2017-2022 All-Hazards Mitigation Plan," this Council finds it acceptable.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STRONGSVILLE, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That based upon the recommendation of the City's Chief of Fire, the Cuyahoga County 2017-2022 All-Hazards Mitigation Plan is hereby adopted as the official Hazard Mitigation Plan of the City of Strongsville, a copy of which is on file in the office of the Fire Chief.

Section 2. That the respective officials and agencies identified in the implementation strategy of the Cuyahoga County 2017-2022 All-Hazards Mitigation Plan are hereby directed to implement the recommended activities assigned to them.
