A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING VARIOUS DONATIONS TO THE CITY OF STRONGSVILLE IN MEMORY OF STRONGSVILLE RESIDENT CHANG-SHI LU, AND TO BE USED FOR THE WOODSHOP LOCATED AT THE WALTER F. EHRSFELT RECREATION & SENIOR CENTER.

WHEREAS, the City of Strongsville Walter F. Ehrnfelt Recreation & Senior Center has a woodshop where residents and non-residents alike may participate in classes and programs related to woodworking; and

WHEREAS, the Senior Center also provides volunteers who perform woodshop services, such as repairing small wood items, chairs, tables, etc., all for a minimal charge; and

WHEREAS, Strongsville resident Chang-Shi Lu was an active member of the Senior Center and thoroughly enjoyed spending time at the woodshop where he developed a passion for woodworking and making gifts for his family and friends for special occasions; and

WHEREAS, regrettably, Chang-Shi Lu passed away on September 23, 2017 and since that time and to date, numerous individuals have made various monetary donations to the Senior Center woodshop in memory of Mr. Lu, in the total amount of \$3,276.00; and

WHEREAS, therefore, the City now will accept such thoughtful donations in memory of Chang-Shi Lu.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STRONGSVILLE, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO:


Section 1. That this Council hereby graciously accepts the above donations from various persons, and along with Mayor Perciak, expresses the City's appreciation for such generous donations, in honor of Chang-Shi Lu, to be utilized for the City's Walter F. Ehrnfelt Recreation & Senior Center woodshop.

Section 2.
