ORDINANCE NO. 2008 - 104

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A STATE OF OHIO ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES CONTRACT FOR THE PURCHASE OF ONE (1) NEW FIRE AERIAL LADDER TRUCK FOR USE BY THE FIRE DEPARTMENT WITH THE SALE, TRADE-IN AND CREDIT FOR AN EXISTING OBSOLETE FIRE TRUCK, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 5513.01(B) provides the opportunity for counties, townships and municipal corporations to participate in contracts of Ohio Department of Administrative Services for the purchase of machinery, materials, supplies or other articles; and

WHEREAS, this Council wishes to take advantage of that opportunity to purchase one (1) new Emergency One fire aerial ladder truck (Schedule No. 7761800408, Index No. STS618X) for use by the Fire Department of the City; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Department has a 1989 Pierce Aerial fire truck, VIN 1P9CA01JXKA040283 that is obsolete and no longer needed for any municipal public purpose; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, §3(e) of the City Charter, the Director of Finance is authorized to sell obsolete or surplus equipment in such manner as Council may by ordinance authorize; and

WHEREAS, this Council is desirous of having the Director of Finance sell and trade-in the existing obsolete or surplus 1989 Pierce Aerial fire truck, and have the selling price credited against the purchase price of the new aerial ladder truck with accessories;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STRONGSVILLE, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That this Council finds that the Fire Department of the City of Strongsville has a 1989 Pierce Aerial fire truck, VIN 1P9CA01JXKA040283, which is obsolete and no longer needed for any municipal purpose, and further finds that it will be in the best interests of the City to sell and trade-in such 1989 fire truck and have the selling price applied as a credit against the purchase of one (1) new fire aerial ladder truck.

Section 2. That the Mayor accordingly be and is hereby authorized and directed to request authority in the name of the City of Strongsville to participate in an Ohio Department of Administrative Services contract with Emergency One, Inc. for the purchase of one (1) new Emergency One fire aerial ladder truck, and for the sale and trade-in of the existing 1989 Pierce Aerial fire truck in the amount of \$60,000.00; and providing that the sale price be credited towards the purchase price of the new Emergency One fire aerial ladder truck, resulting in a total net contract price for the purchase of the new fire aerial ladder truck with accessories not to exceed \$724,566.00.


Section 3. That the City of Strongsville hereby agrees to be bound by the terms and conditions prescribed by the Director of Administrative Services for such purchases, and to directly pay the vendor, under each such contract of the Ohio Department of Administrative Services in which the City participates for items it receives pursuant to the contract.

Section 4. That the Mayor and Director of Finance be and are hereby authorized to enter into and execute such agreements and documents as may be necessary to participate in the Ohio Department of Administrative Services Cooperative Purchasing Program.


Section 5. That the funds for the purposes of said contract have been appropriated and shall be paid from the Fire Vehicle Fund.

Section 6. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council; and that all deliberations of this Council, and any of its committees, that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 7. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety and welfare of the City, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to enter into said contract to provide for the continuity of services and operation of the City of Strongsville Fire Department, to provide updated equipment for fire rescue services, and to conserve public funds. Therefore, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.






