MINUTES OF MEETING

June 11, 2024

The Planning Commission of the City of Strongsville met at the City Council Chambers located at 18688 Royalton Road, on *Tuesday, June 11, 2024 at 5:50 p.m.*

The following was discussed:

ORDINANCE NO. 2024-090: Mr. Kolick stated this is the parcel on the southeast corner of Prospect and Route 82, which is currently zoned Local Business and they are proposing to extend the Local Business zoning to the east. They are requesting the rezoning of 0.8306 acres to add onto the Local Business parcel that is there now. The reason for the rezoning is because the current parcel is to small to use other than for a possible carwash or an individual office building. They came in to talk to us about a potential restaurant; however, a restaurant would have to be attached to another use in the Local Business zone. If this is approved by the Commission and City Council it would still need to go on the ballot because the current zoning is R1-75 and your recommendation tonight would be for this to be placed on the ballot for this November. This rezoning would be taking a portion of the R1-75 zoning that is between the Local Business zoning and the detention basin and the new town homes that are going in now. This would make sense from a zoning standpoint because there is a natural barrier with the detention basin. City Council has referred this to the Planning Commission for your recommendation and this will go back to Council where they will hold a public hearing, if approved by Council, it will go on the ballot. Ultimately, the electorate will determine whether the property will be rezoned from R1-75 to Local Business. If there are any questions, I can answer them here; otherwise, when we go onto the floor I will incorporate what was said here into the minutes.
