AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1246.02 OF TITLE SIX OF PART TWELVE-PLANNING AND ZONING CODE OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF STRONGSVILLE CONCERNING THE COMPOSITION OF THE ARCHITECTURAL REVIEW BOARD, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STRONGSVILLE, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That Section 1246.02 of Chapter 1246 of Title Six of Part Twelve-Planning and Zoning Code of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Strongsville concerning Establishment; Composition and Qualifications of the Architectural Review Board, be and is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

1246.02 ESTABLISHMENT; COMPOSITION AND QUALIFICATIONS.

There is hereby established effective June 1, 2009, an Architectural Review Board consisting of six (6) members including the City Building Commissioner or designee from the Building Department, the City Engineer or designee from the Engineering Department, the City Planner, the Coordinator of City Natural Resources and two (2) non-City employee members to be appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by Council. One appointed member shall be a registered architect authorized to practice architecture under the laws of the State of Ohio, and one appointed member shall be a landscape architect. (Ord. 2009-014. Passed 4-20-09.)

Section 2. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council; and that all deliberations of this Council, and any of its committees, that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety and welfare of the City, and for the further reason that it is necessary to amend the composition of members serving on the Architectural Review Board. Therefore, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1246.02 OF TITLE SIX OF PART TWELVE-PLANNING AND ZONING CODE OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF STRONGSVILLE CONCERNING THE COMPOSITION OF THE ARCHITECTURAL REVIEW BOARD, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY, AS AMENDED.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STRONGSVILLE, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That Section 1246.02 of Chapter 1246 of Title Six of Part Twelve-Planning and Zoning Code of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Strongsville concerning Establishment; Composition and Qualifications of the Architectural Review Board, be and is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

1246.02 ESTABLISHMENT; COMPOSITION AND QUALIFICATIONS.

There is hereby established effective June 1, 2009, an Architectural Review Board consisting of six (6) members including the City Building Commissioner or designee from the Building Department, the City Engineer or designee from the Engineering Department, the City Planner, the Coordinator of City Natural Resources and two (2) non-City employee members to be appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by Council. One appointed member shall be a registered architect authorized to practice architecture under the laws of the State of Ohio, and one appointed member shall be a landscape architect. The appointed non-City employee members may be a registered architect and/or a landscape architect. Any appointed non-City employee member, other than a registered architect and/or a landscape architect, shall be a resident of the City of Strongsville.

Section 2. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council; and that all deliberations of this Council, and any of its committees, that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety and welfare of the City, and for the further reason that it is necessary to amend the composition of members serving on the Architectural Review Board. Therefore, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

ORDINANCE NO. 2025 - 012

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE BY INTERNET AUCTION, OF CERTAIN OBSOLETE PROPERTY NO LONGER NEEDED FOR ANY MUNICIPAL PURPOSE BY THE CITY'S SERVICE DEPARTMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STRONGSVILLE, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO:

- **Section 1.** That this Council finds that the Service Department of the City of Strongsville is in possession of certain vehicles, equipment and materials, which are obsolete, surplus, have little monetary value, and are no longer needed for any municipal purpose, as more particularly described in Exhibit "A", a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, and further finds, therefore, that it will be in the best interest of the City that such property be sold by public internet auction through **GOVDEALS**.
- **Section 2.** That pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 721.15, the City is authorized to sell or dispose of property by internet auction; and that, pursuant to Article IV, Section 3(e) of the City Charter, the Mayor and Director of Finance be and are hereby authorized to dispose of such obsolete tangible property identified in Exhibit "A" and to perform all acts required in furtherance thereof.
- Section 3. That the Director of Finance and the Mayor, therefore, are authorized to retain the services of GOVDEALS to effectuate the sale of such obsolete property by internet auction through an appropriate user agreement between the City and GovDeals, and in a form to be approved by the Law Director; and that the Director of Finance, Mayor and the Director of Public Service be and are further authorized and directed to execute all documents and perform all acts required to complete the sale of such obsolete and unneeded property by public internet auction.
- **Section 4.** That the public internet auction will be conducted through GovDeals in accordance with its rules, regulations and procedures, including listing of the obsolete and unneeded property for sale by auction to the public on the internet. That as required by law, the property will be listed for ten (10) days, including Saturdays, Sundays and legal holidays.
- **Section 5.** That the net proceeds of the operation of this Ordinance shall be deposited into the Street Construction, Maintenance & Repair Fund and the Sanitary Sewer Fund; and any funds required for the purposes of this Ordinance have been appropriated and shall be paid from the Street, Construction, Maintenance & Repair Fund and the Sanitary Sewer Fund.
- **Section 6.** That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council; and that all deliberations of this Council, and any of its committees, that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 7. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety and welfare of the City, and for the further reason that the immediate sale of such obsolete and unneeded municipal property is necessary in order to provide necessary storage space for the Service Department, to enable the Department to replace obsolete equipment, and to conserve public funds. Therefore, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A STATE OF OHIO ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES CONTRACT FOR THE PURCHASE OF TWO (2) NEW 2025 FREIGHTLINER M2 PLUS CHASSIS LIFE LINE "CUSTOM HIGHLINER" AMBULANCE UNITS WITH RELATED VEHICLE APPURTENANCES FOR USE BY THE FIRE DEPARTMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 5513.01(B) provides the opportunity for counties, townships and municipal corporations to participate in contracts of Ohio Department of Administrative Services for the purchase of machinery, materials, supplies, vehicles or other articles; and

WHEREAS, this Council wishes to take advantage of that opportunity to purchase two (2) new 2025 Freightliner M2 Plus Chassis Life Line "Custom Highliner" Ambulance Units with related vehicle appurtenances (Contract No. STS023796, Index No. STS233), for use by the Fire Department of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STRONGSVILLE, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO:

- Section 1. That the Mayor accordingly be and is hereby authorized and directed to request authority in the name of the City of Strongsville to participate in an Ohio Department of Administrative Services contract with LIFE LINE EMERGENCY (through authorized dealer PFUND SUPERIOR SALES CO., INC.) for the purchase of two (2) new 2025 Freightliner M2 Plus Chassis Life Line "Custom Highliner" Units with related vehicle appurtenances, in a total amount not to exceed \$800,362.00, as reflected on Exhibit A attached hereto.
- **Section 2.** That the City of Strongsville hereby agrees to be bound by the terms and conditions prescribed by the Director of Administrative Services for such purchases, and to directly pay the vendor, under each such contract of the Ohio Department of Administrative Services in which the City participates for items it receives pursuant to the contract.
- **Section 3.** That the Mayor and Director of Finance be and are hereby authorized to enter into and execute such agreements and documents as may be necessary to participate in the Ohio Department of Administrative Services Office of Procurement Services.
- **Section 4.** That the funds for the purposes of said purchase and Agreement have been appropriated and shall be paid from the Emergency Vehicle Fund.
- **Section 5.** That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council; and that all deliberations of this Council, and any of its committees, that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

PAYMENT OF SALES AND USE TAXES: The price for the motor vehicle specified in this agreement does not include Sales Taxes and Use Taxes (Federal, State, or Local) unless expressly stated. The purchaser assumes and agrees to pay, unless prohibited by law, and such Sales, Use, or Occupational Taxes imposed on or applicable to the transaction covered by this agreement, regardless of which party may have primary tax liability.

EXECUTION OF OTHER DOCUMENTS: The Purchaser, before or at the time of delivery of the motor vehicle covered by this agreement will execute such other forms of agreement or documents as may be required by the terms and conditions of payment indicated on the front of this order or as required by law.

PAYMENT OF BALANCE DUE AND ACCEPTANCE BY PURCHASER: The Purchaser agrees to pay the balance due on delivery pursuant to the terms specified and to accept delivery of the ordered motor vehicle. AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE AT PUBLIC AUCTION OF CERTAIN OBSOLETE AND SURPLUS POLICE AND SERVICE VEHICLES NO LONGER NEEDED FOR ANY MUNICIPAL PURPOSE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STRONGSVILLE, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO:

- **Section 1.** That this Council finds that the Police and Service Departments of the City of Strongsville have various obsolete and surplus vehicles, as described in Exhibit A, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, which are unfit for public use by reason of obsolescence or as surplus items, and are no longer needed for any municipal purpose; and further finds that it will be in the best interests of the City that such vehicles be sold at a public auction.
- Section 2. That, pursuant to Article IV, Section 3(e) of the City Charter, the Mayor and Director of Finance be and are hereby authorized and directed to sell such vehicles at public auction.
- Section 3. That the Director of Finance and the Mayor are authorized to retain the services of the MANHEIM MARKETING, INC. AUTO AUCTION to effectuate the sale of all such vehicles for auction; and the Director of Finance and Mayor are further authorized and directed to execute all documents and perform all acts required to complete the auction and the sale of the auctioned vehicles.
- **Section 4.** That any proceeds of sale shall be deposited into the General Fund and Emergency Vehicle Fund, and any funds required for the purposes of this Ordinance have been appropriated and shall be paid from the General Fund and Emergency Vehicle Fund.
- **Section 5.** That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council; and that all deliberations of this Council, and any of its committees, that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.
- **Section 6.** That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety and welfare of the City, and for the further reason that the immediate sale of such obsolete and surplus vehicles is necessary in order to provide needed storage space for the Police and Service Departments, and to conserve public funds. Therefore, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
