RESOLUTION NO. 2026 – 054

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS FOR THE REPLACEMENT OF TWO (2) ELEVATORS AT THE CITY OF STRONGSVILLE WALTER F. EHRRNFELT RECREATION & SENIOR CENTER FACILITY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STRONGSVILLE, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor be and is hereby authorized to advertise for bids for the replacement of two (2) elevators at the City of Strongsville Walter F. Ehrnfelt Recreation & Senior Center facility, in accordance with specifications on file in the office of the Director of Recreation & Senior Services, which are in all respects hereby approved.

Section 2. That the funds for the purposes of this Resolution have been appropriated and shall be paid from the Recreation Capital Improvement Fund.

Section 3. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council; and that all deliberations of the Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 4. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the City, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to authorize advertising for public bidding for these services in order to renovate and replace the elevators at the Walter F. Ehrnfelt Recreation & Senior Center Facility to protect the safety of City employees, guests and invitees to City-owned facilities, and to conserve public funds. Therefore, provided, this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
