CALL TO ORDER:

Motion to adopt by Mr. Clark, second by Mr. Zacharyasz, Jr.

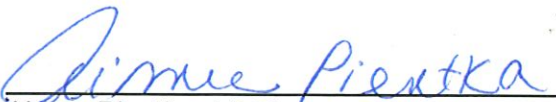
Roll Call: All ayes. Motion carries. Resolution No. 2026-071 ADOPTED.

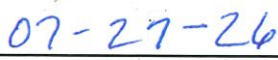
