



## YOUTH BASKETBALL RESTRICTIONS (in addition to Responsible Restart Ohio):

(FAILURE TO COMPLY WILL RESULT IN THE REMOVAL AND POSSIBLE EXPULSION OF THE PERSON AND OR TEAM)

### EVERYONE (Players, Coaches, Officials, Staff & Spectators):

- Maintain social distancing (at least 6') and other restrictions listed below.
- Report any COVID-19 exposures to the league commissioner.
- Conduct daily symptom checks and stay home if experiencing any COVID related symptoms. Report this to the league commissioner as well.
- Everyone (fans, players, coaches, officials and staff) is REQUIRED to wear face covering while not actively on the court of play.
- No one can congregate in the parking lot or anywhere in or near the venue before, during or after the game.
- Travel to the venue with no one other than those who live in your residence.
- Wash and disinfect hands FREQUENTLY! EVERYONE should bring their own sanitizer to games and practices.
- Games will be scheduled 1 hour and 15 minutes apart to avoid gymnasium congestion.
- To avoid gymnasium congestion players, coaches and parents should not arrive more than 10 minutes before a game. If players are still in the gym at the time of your arrival everyone is to wait in their cars until they can safely enter the gym.

### COACHES:

- If practices occur balls should be disinfected frequently.
- Designate a coach or parent volunteer to be the restrictions "watchdog" or "enforcer."
- Must eliminate the post-game handshakes and any other touching between players (high-fives). Teams can, instead, line-up and give each other a "tip of the cap."
- Ensure all players are sanitizing their hands between segments.
- Ensure players are wearing masks while on the bench and/or not actively in the game. Coaches must also wear their own mask while not actively coaching in the game or practice.

### PLAYERS:

- Social Distancing must be maintained.
- Wear a mask when not actively in a game or practice. A container or baggie with the players names should be on hand for games and practices to avoid mask cross contamination.
- No touch rule (no high-fives, fist bumps, etc...). Use a tip-of-the-cap gesture.
- Disinfect hands when entering and exiting the game or practice drill. Players should have their own sanitizer.

### SPECTATORS:

- Only one parent can be in attendance with a player.
- Masks are required to enter a venue. They must be worn at all times.

### OFFICIALS AND STAFF:

- Disinfect the ball before a game, during time-outs, and half-time.
- Wear a mask at all times. Referees do not need to wear a mask while officiating a game.
