ORDINANCE NO. 2014 – 097

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR PURCHASE OF A SPECIALTY SCOREBOARD FOR THE CITY'S AQUATIC AREA IN THE RECREATION CENTER, AND TO ACCEPT VARIOUS DONATIONS FROM THE STRONGSVILLE CITY SCHOOLS, SWIMSTRONG, AND THE STRONGSVILLE SWIM LEAGUE, TOWARDS PAYMENT THEREOF, WITHOUT PUBLIC BIDDING, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Director of Recreation & Senior Services has indicated that the existing Aquatic Center scoreboard is old, obsolete and deficient by 2014 standards and requires replacement; and

WHEREAS, various Strongsville organizations, including the Strongsville City Schools, SwimStrong and the Strongsville Swim League, have, therefore, been gracious in offering to donate funds to the City's purchase of a new specialty scoreboard as set forth in their letters as Exhibits A-1, A-2 and A-3 attached hereto and which the City is desirous of accepting; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Recreation & Senior Services has recommended a particular specialty sign that would fulfill the City's needs, from a reliable vendor at a highly competitive price, and without any necessity for making modifications to the Aquatic Center's current structure.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STRONGSVILLE, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO, BY UNANIMOUS AFFIRMATIVE VOTE:

Section 1. That this Council finds and determines, as set out in Article V, §5 of the Charter, that there is an immediate and present emergency in the operation of the Department of Recreation & Senior Services of the City of Strongsville, in that it is necessary to purchase a new, upgraded scoreboard for the Aquatic Center, without public bidding, but with the benefit of donations from various charitable community organizations, in order to provide for the proper operation of the Recreation Department, to promote the health, safety and welfare of the residents, and to conserve public funds.

Section 2. That for the reasons aforesaid, this Council hereby approves and authorizes the Mayor to enter into a contract with **COLORADO TIME SYSTEMS** for the purchase and installation of a new aquatic scoreboard, without public bidding, as per

the proposal attached hereto as Exhibit B, in a form approved by the Law Director, and in a total amount not to exceed \$58,485.00, which will be offset by the various donations to be received by the City.


Section 3. That on behalf of the entire community, this Council hereby graciously accepts and expresses its appreciation for the respective monetary donations from the Strongsville City Schools, SwimStrong and the Strongsville Swim League, towards the Aquatic Center sign purchase and installation and which will be used by such organizations during the coming years.

Section 4. That the funds for the City's share of such purchase have been appropriated and shall be paid from the Multi-Purpose Complex Fund.

Section 5. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council; and that all deliberations of this Council, and any of its committees, that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 6. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety and welfare of the City, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to approve and authorize the above purchase in order to provide for the continuity and updating of services and operation of the City's Recreation Department for the benefit of residents and members, and to conserve public funds. Therefore, provided this Ordinance receives the unanimous vote of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.



1. 120 VAC circuits must be supplied to each Display or Scoreboard as designated in the electrical information provided by CTS and ongoing access must be given to the electrical switches and or breakers as necessary. (CTS highly recommends the addition of a main power ON/OFF switch for each scoreboard location at a location readily available to the equipment operators.)
2. PVC conduits with wall/deck boxes must be installed per CTS specifications and must have pull strings in place.
3. Equipment for installation must be physically present at installation location and readily available.
4. If a special structural mount is required for the Display/Scoreboard, it must be completed prior to the arrival of CTS's Customer Service Specialist.
5. A two-man scissors lift (or equivalent) must be provided, and available for the entire time the CTS Customer Service Specialist is on-site.
6. All deck work must be completed (concrete, tile, grout, etc.), all painting in the vicinity of the install location must be completed and the installation areas must be free of any obstructions (including dust, dirt, construction materials, and trash) prior to the arrival of CTS's Customer Service Specialist.
7. Two semi-skilled labors must be available to assist with the installation process under the direction of the CTS's Customer Service Specialist, and be dedicated for that sole purpose. The number and quality of laborers determines the time necessary for completion.


The City of Strongsville will be purchasing a new scoreboard for the Ehrnfelt Recreation Center's aquatic center. The total cost of this scoreboard will be \$58,485. The purchase of this scoreboard will be paid for only partially by the City of Strongsville, with other organizations donating funds from Strongsville City Schools, SwimStrong and Strongsville Swim League in the following amounts:

City of Strongsville	\$18,161.67
Strongsville City Schools	\$18,161.66
SwimStrong	\$18,161.67
Strongsville Swim League	\$4,000.00

Upon installation of the scoreboard the City will assume ownership of the scoreboard and will be responsible for the maintenance thereafter.

We have only approached Colorado Time Systems for this scoreboard because they are the sole market leader in this type of system and most competitive for exactly what we want. Furthermore, this system will also allow us to utilize the current make up of our aquatic center, and we will not have to alter anything on top of or underneath the deck. Going with another type of system would have been substantially more expensive and would require alterations to our current deck.

Based upon the above, we submit this situation warrants waiver of bidding.
