AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A STATE OF OHIO ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES CONTRACT FOR THE PURCHASE OF ONE (1) NEW JACOBSEN AR522 MOWER FOR USE BY THE SERVICE DEPARTMENT; FOR TRADE-IN OF AN OBSOLETE JACOBSEN HR5111 MOWER, AND TO HAVE THE SALE PRICE APPLIED TO THE PURCHASE PRICE, WITHOUT PUBLIC BIDDING FOR SUCH SALE; TO ACCEPT VARIOUS DONATIONS FROM THE STRONGSVILLE SOCCER CLUB. **STRONGSVILLE BASEBALL STRONGSVILLE** ASSOCIATION, AND **FOOTBALL** LEAGUE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 5513.01(B) provides the opportunity for counties, townships and municipal corporations to participate in contracts of Ohio Department of Administrative Services for the purchase of machinery, materials, supplies or other articles; and

WHEREAS, this Council wishes to take advantage of that opportunity to purchase one (1) new Jacobsen AR522 mower (Schedule No. 800236, Index No. STS515) for use by the Service Department of the City; and

WHEREAS, the Service Department has a Jacobsen HR5111 mower that is obsolete and no longer needed for any municipal public purpose; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, §3(e) of the City Charter, the Director of Finance is authorized to sell obsolete or surplus equipment in such manner as Council may by ordinance authorize; and

WHEREAS, this Council is desirous of having the Director of Finance sell and trade-in the existing obsolete Jacobsen HR5111 mower, and have the selling price credited against the purchase price of the new Jacobsen AR522 mower, all without public auction or bidding; and

WHEREAS, various Strongsville organizations, including the Strongsville Soccer Club, Strongsville Baseball Association and Strongsville Football League have been gracious in offering to donate funds towards the City's purchase of the new Jacobsen AR522 mower, as set forth in Exhibits A-1, A-2 and A-3 attached hereto and which the City is desirous of accepting.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STRONGSVILLE, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO BY UNANIMOUS AFFIRMATIVE VOTE:

Section 1. That this Council finds and determines that there is an immediate and present emergency in the operation of the Service Department of the City of Strongsville which has a Jacobsen HR5111 mower, which is obsolete and no longer needed for any municipal purpose, and further finds that it will be in the best interests of the City to sell and trade-in such Jacobsen HR 5111 mower and have the selling price applied as a credit against the purchase of one (1) new Jacobsen AR522 mower, without public auction or bidding, but also with the benefit of donations from various charitable community organizations.

Section 2. That the Mayor accordingly be and is hereby authorized and directed to request authority in the name of the City of Strongsville to participate in an Ohio Department of Administrative Services contract with JACOBSEN, A TEXTRON COMPANY (through authorized dealer BAKER VEHICLE SYSTEMS, INC.) for the purchase of one (1) new Jacobsen AR522 mower, and for the sale and trade-in of the existing Jacobsen HR5111 mower, in the total amount of \$5,000.00, without public bidding, and providing that the sale price be credited towards the purchase price of the new Jacobsen AR522 mower, resulting in a total net contract price for the purchase of the new Jacobsen AR522 mower, not to exceed \$37,000.00, all as more fully set forthin Exhibit B attached hereto, and in a form to be approved by the Law Director, but which will be offset by the various donations totaling \$10,500.00 received by the City.

Section 3. That the City of Strongsville hereby agrees to be bound by the terms and conditions prescribed by the Director of Administrative Services for such purchases, and to directly pay the vendor, under each such contract of the Ohio Department of Administrative Services in which the City participates for items it receives pursuant to the contract.

Section 4. That the Mayor and Director of Finance be and are hereby authorized to enter into and execute such agreements and documents as may be necessary to participate in the Ohio Department of Administrative Services Cooperative Purchasing Program.

Section 5. That on behalf of the entire community, this Council hereby graciously accepts and expresses its appreciation for the respective monetary donations from the Strongsville Soccer Club, Strongsville Baseball Association, and Strongsville Football League, towards the new Jacobsen AR522 mower purchase, which will benefit each of these organizations that utilize the City's playing fields.

Section 6. That the net funds for the purposes of the City's said purchase and Agreement have been appropriated and shall be paid from the Street Construction, Maintenance & Repair Fund.

Section 7. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council; and that all deliberations of this Council, and any of its committees, that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 8. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety and welfare of the City, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to enter into said contract to provide for the continuity of services and operation of the City of Strongsville Service Department, to provide updated equipment for maintenance of the City's playing fields, and to conserve public funds. Therefore, provided this Ordinance receives the unanimous vote of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.


