ORDINANCE NO. 2015 – 035

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE PURCHASE OF GENERAL PAVEMENT SERVICES FOR 2015 FOR USE BY THE SERVICE DEPARTMENT OF THE CITY OF STRONGSVILLE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, the City has advertised and received bids for the purchase of general pavement services for use by the Service Department of the City of Strongsville for a period ending December 31, 2015; and

WHEREAS, Council is desirous of proceeding to award and enter into a contract for such services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STRONGSVILLE, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO:

**Section 1.** That this Council hereby finds and determines that the bid submitted by **CROSSROADS ASPHALT RECYCLING, INC.**, for the purchase of general pavement services through December 31, 2015 for use by the Service Department of the City of Strongsville meets the specifications on file in the office of the Director of Public Service; is in compliance with the applicable requirements for bids and contracts established by the laws of the City and the State; and is the lowest and best bid for the proposed contract. All other bids for this contract are hereby rejected.

**Section 2.** That accordingly the Mayor be and is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with the aforesaid lowest and best bidder for the purchase of general pavement services for use by the Service Department of the City, in accordance with the specifications on file in the office of the Director of Public Service and for the unit prices and sums submitted in such bid, but in any event in a total amount not to exceed \$861,792.00 through December 31, 2015, and in a form to be approved by the Law Director.

**Section 3.** That the funds for the purposes of this Ordinance have been appropriated and shall be paid from the Street Construction, Maintenance and Repair Fund, State Highway Maintenance Fund and Motor Vehicle Fund.

**Section 4.** That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council; and that all deliberations of this Council, and any of its

committees, that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

**Section 5.** That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the City, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to authorize execution of said contract in order to improve and render safe various public roadways in the City, provide for the continuity of services and operation of the Department of Public Service, and to conserve public funds. Therefore, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
