ORDINANCE NO. 2015 – 101

AN ORDINANCE RATIFYING, AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING PARTICIPATION IN OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION CONTRACTS FOR THE PURCHASE OF SODIUM CHLORIDE (ROCK SALT) FOR USE BY THE SERVICE DEPARTMENT OF THE CITY DURING THE 2015-2016 SEASON; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE DIRECTOR OF FINANCE TO DO ALL THINGS NECESSARY TO ENTER INTO AGREEMENTS IN CONNECTION THEREWITH; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 5513.01(B) provides the opportunity for counties, townships and municipal corporations to participate in contracts of the Ohio Department of Transportation for the purchase of machinery, materials, supplies or other articles; and

WHEREAS, this Council wishes to take advantage of that opportunity in the ongoing purchase as required of sodium chloride (rock salt) during the 2015-2016 winter season (State of Ohio Department of Transportation, Winter-Use Salt Contract No. 018-16) for use by the Service Department of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STRONGSVILLE, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That Council ratifies, approves and authorizes the Mayor's request for authority in the name of the City of Strongsville to participate in Ohio Department of Transportation contracts for the purchase of sodium chloride (rock salt) at a rate per ton to be determined through the ODOT bidding process for use by the Service Department of the City, in a total amount estimated at 12,000 tons for the winter season and contract, but in an amount estimated not to exceed \$800,000.00 for such tonnage, as reflected in the Participation Agreement attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein, which contract(s) the Department will have entered into pursuant to Revised Code Section 5513.01(B).

Section 2. That the City of Strongsville hereby agrees to be bound by the terms and conditions prescribed by the Director of the Ohio Department of Transportation for such purchases, and to directly pay the vendor under such contract of the Ohio Department of Transportation in which the City participates for the items it receives pursuant to the contract.

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Section 3. That the Mayor and Director of Finance be and are hereby authorized to enter into and execute such agreements and documents as may be necessary to participate in the Ohio Department of Transportation Cooperative Purchasing Program.

Section 4. That the funds for the purposes of said contract have been appropriated for 2015 and shall be paid from the Street Construction, Maintenance & Repair Fund and the State Highway Maintenance Fund.

Section 5. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council; and that all deliberations of this Council, and any of its committees, that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 6. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety and welfare, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to participate in such program and purchase such rock salt materials for the next winter season in order to provide continuity of services to residents of the City and in the operation of the Department of Public Service, to ensure safe passage on City streets, to comply with Ohio Department of Transportation deadlines, and conserve public funds. Therefore, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor, otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

PLEASE READ BEFORE SUBMITTING:

By submitting the below participation form and a resolution/ordinance for the Winter-Use Salt Contract (018-16) you will be bound to purchase at least 90% of the salt quantities requested. Conversely, you will be able to purchase up to 110% of the salt quantities requested. After the deadline noted below, you cannot change your position or back out of this contract at any time. NO EXCEPTIONS. The Winter salt contract will be valid from November 1, 2015 through May 31, 2016. Orders may be placed beginning November 1st. Once an order has been placed, your salt supplier will have seven (7) calendar days to deliver the balance of your order. You will be responsible for placing all orders and making payments directly to your salt supplier. You will also be responsible for settling all contract disputes between your Political Subdivision and your awarded salt supplier.

The Winter-Use Contract will be put out to bid approx. May 19th and bids will open around June 16th. We will share the bid results by email shortly thereafter.

This participation form AND your Resolution/Ordinance must be submitted by no later than 5:00PM on MONDAY, MAY 18th. The Department will NOT accept your salt request if you fail to attach a completed Resolution or Ordinance to the form (first field on the form). NO EXCEPTIONS. After May 18th, you will not be given an opportunity to withdraw or reduce your requested tonnage from the contract.

PLEASE NOTE: YOU MUST ATTACH AN APPROVED RESOLUTION/ORDINANCE TO YOUR FORM. EVEN THOSE WHO HAVE ALREADY SUBMITTED ONE FOR THE SUMMER CONTRACT FORM MUST RE-ATTACH IT TO THEIR WINTER FORM. YOU MAY USE THE SAME RESOLUTION/ORDINANCE FOR EITHER CONTRACT.

It is your responsibility to verify that your submitted form has been received and that the tonnages you have requested are correct. We have provided a link below that you can use to check to make sure your form was submitted properly and that all information is correct.
